Sandy Town Council is an elected statutory body of 15 members with legal powers to provide services for the community of Sandy including Beeston. The council makes its strategic decisions as a body at public meetings. Day to day operations are managed by a small team of trained officers. The council publishes its strategic plan on its website along with all its policy documents, information about the council and community news. The Town Council regularly reviews its activities and looks for new opportunities to enhance the experience of living in Sandy.
