#### 5 Tree Survey Work (135-2016/2017)

Members were reminded that at a meeting of the Community Services and Environment Committee on 30th January 2017 Members received a report on Town Council owned trees at Beeston Green, Bedford Road Recreation Ground, the Sandy Cemetery and the Church Yard. Following a review of the report it was resolved to recommend that the most urgent tree work be carried out within 60 days and that the costs of the work be approved by the Town Council.
