6 Items for Information (38-2022/23)

Members noted the following decision from Central Bedfordshire Council:

- a) CB/21/04412/FULL 18 The Green for erection of 2 dwellings. Members discussed this at a meeting of Development Scrutiny on 8 November 2021 and resolved to make no objections but to urge that due diligence is given to mitigate the loss of wildlife habitat. This has been granted by CBC with conditions that include that the development shall be undertaken in full accordance with the councils adopted environmental code of practice; no development shall take place until a precautionary working method statement for great crested newts has been submitted and approved; and an ecological enhancement strategy for the creation of new wildlife features has been submitted.
- b) CB/22/02874/FULL 9 London Road for change of use to mother and baby assessment service. Members discussed this at a meeting of Development Scrutiny on 15 August 2022 and resolved to make no objection to the change of use but objected to the location. This application was granted by CBC.

Members also noted that application CB/22/01964/REG3 – land adjacent to 17 The Green for erection of 6 affordable homes will be discussed by CBC's Development Management Committee on 28 September 2022. If members wish to speak on this application the office needs to let CBC know by 27 September.

A member asked if there had been an update as to what is happening with the land opposite Tesco. The Administrator has been in contact with CBC and CBC Ward Cllr Caroline Maudlin, but as yet has not heard back. She will continue to chase.
